Serials Solutions -- Presenter, Steve Mackey

Question from participants:

- Does it have autocorrect feature? Yes
- Is truncation supported? Yes
- How does the system select importance? Can be defined in the client center.

Ebsco Discovery Service – Presenter, Tony Larsen

- Single point of access-full-text content
- Link resolver available free of cost

- Superior Relevance Ranking: (subject headings, article titles, author keyword, keywords within abstract, keywords within text)
- Ability to limit to provider such as World Book, Medline.....
- Authentication is asked for login information when you choose full text link or index-once login is complete you are logged in for the session-you can set this up the way you would like

OCLC WorldShare Management Paul Cappuzzello

- Single discovery service search
- Intuitive links to licensed and open access
- Advanced search gives you the ability to add databases you want to search
- Available online-would like it to pull up full text articles and ebook formats-currently this is not available
- Apps from the OCLC WorldShare Platform. Creation, sharing and use of new applications will enhance patron experience.
- Delivery system-wide efficiencies across back-office functions while providing new ways for libraries to share resources

Debrief Discussion

- Commercial the first two presentations
- Liked OCLC presentation, gave me a warm and Fuzzy feeling
- Enjoyed all three presentations-very impressed
- Sandi said she subscribed with EDS but it is still too new
- Do they all offer citations? Yes
- Conflict with what we are doing now, except OCLC-mapping and digital
- OCLC faceted was more technical: more library centric-not set up for end users
- Chapters available now as a facet
- Structure the interface will be challenging
