

**VI. GENERAL FUND AND MISCELLANIOUS REVENUE FUND****C.1 Wal-Mart Foundation Grant – Information Item**

Through collaboration among First Lady Lori Otter, the Idaho Library Association, and the Idaho Community Foundation, the Idaho Commission for Libraries received a grant of \$98,000 from the Wal-Mart Foundation for “Strengthening Library Services for Youth in Idaho.” The Commission received 53 grant applications requesting a total of \$308,000.

Funded proposals presented new and creative services, articulated a community need based on demographic information and/or research, provided evidence of planning and more details about project activities, demonstrated strong partnerships, had appropriate means of reaching their target audience, and demonstrated how the project could be continued.

The 14 funded projects are:

- Ada Community Library – Learning Resources for Tweens and Teens \$10,000
- Boise Public Library – Reaching Immigrant Families \$10,000
- Boundary County District Library, Bonners Ferry – Teen Services: Online Magazine and Writing Workshops \$5,000

- Cambridge Community Library – New Teen Space and Paperback Collection \$4,000
- Coeur d’Alene Public Library – Gaming Programs for 5th-12th grades \$7,000
- E. Bonner Co. District Library, Sandpoint – Juvenile Detention Center Outreach \$10,000
- E. Owyhee County District Library, Grand View – New Programming for All Ages \$10,000
- Garden City Public Library – Cognitive and Constructive Play \$4,000
- Kuna District Library – Gaming Programs for Kids and Teens \$4,000
- Lewiston City Library – New Teen Space and Publishing Workshop \$10,000
- Nampa Public Library – Super Saturday Intergenerational Programs \$2,000 (partial)
