

**V. FEDERAL FUND****A.1 Finances - IMLS Funding Update – Information Item**

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Federal Fiscal Year 2017

Lacking a FY2017 budget (October 1, 2016 – September 30, 2017), the federal government is operating under a Continuing Resolution (CR) through April 28, 2017. As it has done in several past years, the Institute of Museum and Library Services (IMLS) has issued partial LSTA awards to the state library agencies. Idaho's partial award is \$953,831, approximately 73% of our FY2016 award. The awards for FY2012 through FY2016 were:

Agencies have two years to spend a given year's funding, and historically the Commission has spent the majority of its LSTA funds in the second year. This practice gives us a buffer against delayed or reduced federal budgets. We anticipate we will begin spending the FY2017 funds in August of 2017.

The current projection from the ALA Washington Office is that Congress will wait until the last minute to pass a new CR at the end of April, and that it will likely be based on the FY2016 budget.

Federal Fiscal Year 2018

The President's FY2018 budget blueprint request to Congress eliminates all funding for IMLS for FY2018. The budget blueprint is the beginning of the FY2018 appropriations and negotiation process; it will be up to Congress to determine funding levels before sending FY2018 funding legislation to the President for final consideration.

The Commission has been asked to provide information on recent use of LSTA funds in Idaho to the Idaho Library Association (ILA) and the wider library community. In addition to brief background information on both IMLS and LSTA, the following has been posted on our website and sent to the ILA Board.

The Idaho Commission for Libraries is the designated recipient of Idaho's LSTA funds, which have averaged about \$1,280,000 per year over the past five years. LSTA funds and mandated state matching funds support virtually all of the statewide programs and services the Commission provides to Idaho libraries. LSTA now represents 30% of the Commission's annual operating expenditures, with 29% of the staff being fully supported with LSTA funds.

**FUNDING:** In SFY 2016, the Commission for Libraries was appropriated \$3,583,400 in state funds. Its LSTA allotment for federal fiscal year 2015 (spent primarily in SFY 2016) was \$1,285,415, about \$0.78 per Idahoan.

In SFY 2017, the Commission’s state appropriation was \$3,822,300. The LSTA allotment for federal fiscal year 2016 (spent primarily in SFY 2017) was \$1,298,817, about \$0.77 per Idahoan.

**STAFFING:** Of the 37.5 positions at the Commission for Libraries, 26.5 are state-funded and 11 are LSTA-funded (1 vacancy in 2016, now filled as the Broadband Consultant position). Seven state-funded positions are used as match for the federal funds.

Elimination of funding for the Institute of Museum and Library Services, as proposed by the Trump Administration’s FY2018 Budget Blueprint, would fundamentally change the impact of the Commission for Libraries:

- Loss of 11 full-time positions, 29% of the staff,
- Loss of over 20% of the personnel budget, and
- Loss of over 36% of the operating budget devoted to programming and services for Idaho libraries.

The Commission would need to cut most programs entirely and focus on 1 or 2 identified to be most critical to building the capacity of Idaho libraries, or change its mission.
