

## **LiLI Databases (LiLI-D) Calendar Year 2007 Report**

### ***Cost of LiLI-D in Calendar Year 2007***

#### **License Costs for LiLI-D**

\$530,666<sup>1</sup>

#### **Cost per Idahoan**

35¢

#### **Cost per Logon**

In 2007 there were 780,679 sessions/logins to the LiLI Databases. The cost per logon was 68¢. That's 3¢ more than 2006.

#### **Cost per Full Text Article**

The cost per LiLI-D article in calendar year 2007 was 51¢. That's a 13¢ increase over calendar year 2006. The change is almost wholly due to a sharp decrease in the number of full text articles accessed. The reason for this decrease is likely attributable in part to the introduction of a new lineup of databases and users' lack of familiarity with them.

During 2007, Idahoans downloaded, printed or e-mailed the texts of magazine, journal, newspaper, encyclopedia and reference book articles 1,032,213 times.

### ***Use of LiLI in 2007***

#### **Idaho Population**

The average Idahoan logged onto a LiLI Database .52 times in 2007. This is calculated by dividing the number of logins/sessions by the July 1, 2007 population estimate of 1,499,402<sup>2</sup>.

#### **LiLI Users**


