Songs and Rhymes:

Or you might fall in! (*baby falls between legs*)

She fell into the bathtub (*move baby side to side*)

She fell into the sink (*move baby side to side*)

She fell into the raspberry jam (*fall between legs*)

And came out pink (*lift baby up*)

We put her in the backyard (*bounce baby on lap*)

and left her in the rain (*make rain with fingers*)

By half past suppertime (*move baby side to side*)

It washed her clean again (*big hug*)
