- A short description about the creation. What media, computer program, or design method was used:

Students created their own vinyl stickers using our US Cutter machine. To do so, they had to find (or create) images; transfer them to Adobe Illustrator to make them into .jpg images; transfer to SCAL Pro softer; convert them to traceable images; and then send them to the cutter. After the designs were cut, they had to learn how to weed & transfer.
