Cost per Logon

In Calendar Year 2009 there were 1,052,674 sessions/logins to the LiLI Databases. This is the second highest number of sessions/logins that the LiLI-D databases have ever recorded for a year. The cost per logon was 53¢.

Cost per Full Text Article

The cost per LiLI-D article in Calendar Year 2009 was 35¢. During Calendar Year 2009, Idahoans downloaded, printed or e-mailed the texts of magazine, journal, newspaper, encyclopedia and reference book articles 1,590,255 times.

Cost per Search¹

Idahoans performed 2,077,611 LiLI-D searches in Calendar Year 2009. This calculates out to \$.27 per search.

Use of LiLI in Calendar Year 2009

Idaho Population

The average Idahoan logged onto a LiLI Database 1.468 times in Calendar Year 2009. This uses and July 1, 2009 population estimate of 1,545,801².

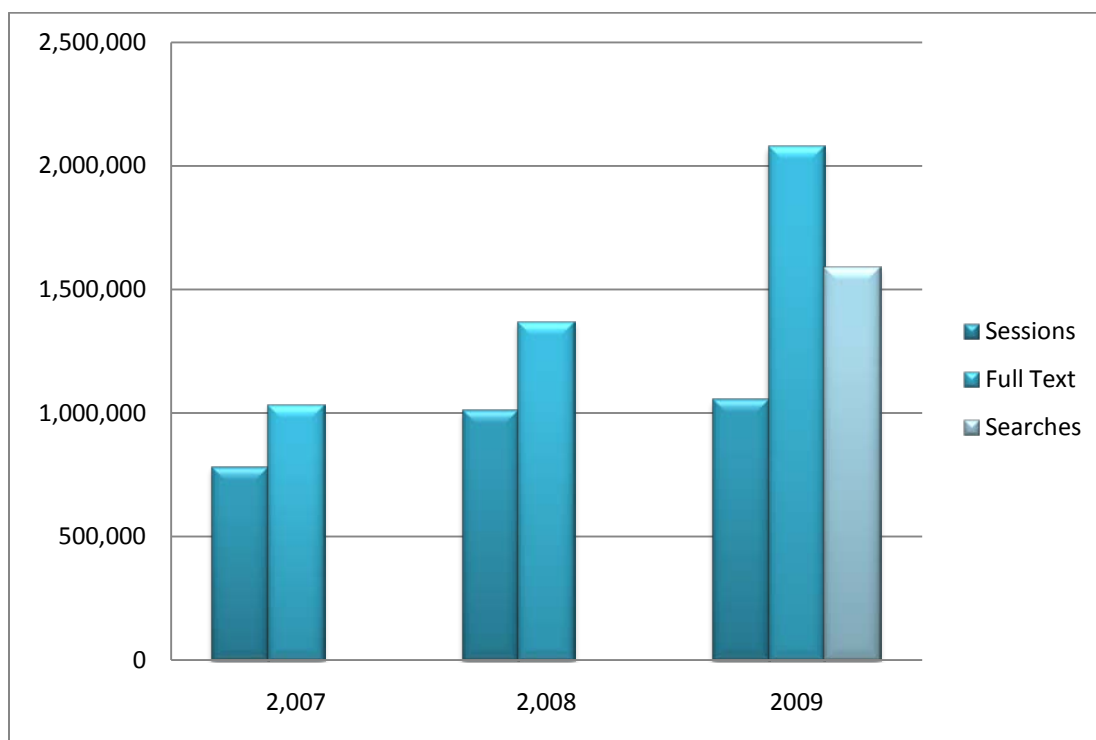
LiLI Users
