



## **LiLI Databases (LiLI-D) FY 04 Report**

### ***Cost of LiLI-D in FY2004***

#### **License Costs for LiLI-D**

\$471,660<sup>1</sup> (contract crosses fiscal year; costs are for calendar year 2004)

#### **Cost per Idahoan**

35¢

#### **Cost per Logon**

With 732,153 sessions/logins on the LiLI Databases in FY04, the cost per logon came to 64¢. This is 16¢ less than FY03 and 56¢ less than FY02.

#### **Cost per Full Text Article**

The cost per LiLI-D article was 31¢ in FY04. During this time, Idahoans downloaded, printed, or e-mailed the texts of magazine, journal, newspaper, encyclopedia, and reference book articles 1,511,045 times.

### ***Use of LiLI in FY2004***

#### **Idaho Population**

The average Idahoan logged onto a LiLI Database .54 times in FY04. This uses a July 1, 2003 population estimate of 1,366,332<sup>2</sup>.

#### **LiLI Users**

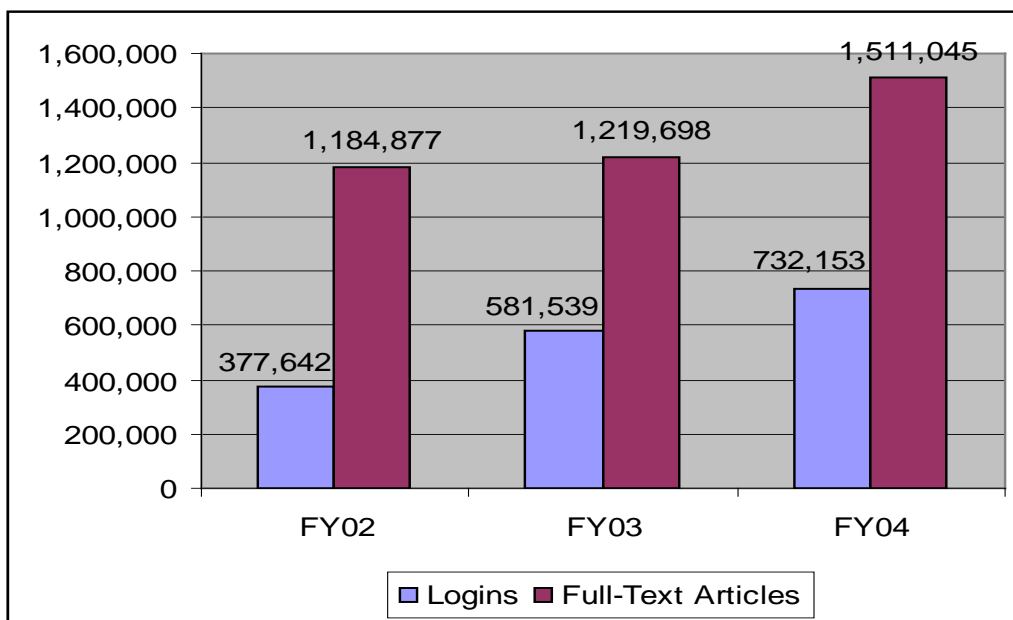
