Cost of LiLI-D in FY2004

License Costs for LiLI-D

Cost per Logon

With 732,153 sessions/logins on the LiLI Databases in FY04, the cost per logon came to 64¢. This is 16¢ less than FY03 and 56¢ less than FY02.

Cost per Full Text Article

The cost per LiLI-D article was 31¢ in FY04. During this time, Idahoans downloaded, printed, or e-mailed the texts of magazine, journal, newspaper, encyclopedia, and reference book articles 1,511,045 times.

Use of LiLI in FY2004

Idaho Population

The average Idahoan logged onto a LiLI Database .54 times in FY04. This uses a July 1, 2003 population estimate of 1,366,332².


LiLI Users
