Cost per Logon

In FY09 there were 3,677,924 sessions/logins to the LiLI Databases. This is the highest number of sessions/logins that the LiLI-D databases have ever recorded for a year. The cost per logon was 15¢.

Cost per Full Text Article

The cost per LiLI-D article in FY09 was 66¢. During FY09, Idahoans downloaded, printed or e-mailed the texts of magazine, journal, newspaper, encyclopedia and reference book articles 846,975 times.

Cost per Search¹

Idahoans performed 1,396,216 LiLI-D searches in FY09. This calculates out to \$.40 per search.

Use of LiLI in FY2009

Idaho Population

The average Idahoan logged onto a LiLI Database 2.41 times in FY09. This uses and July 1, 2008 population estimate of 1,523,816².

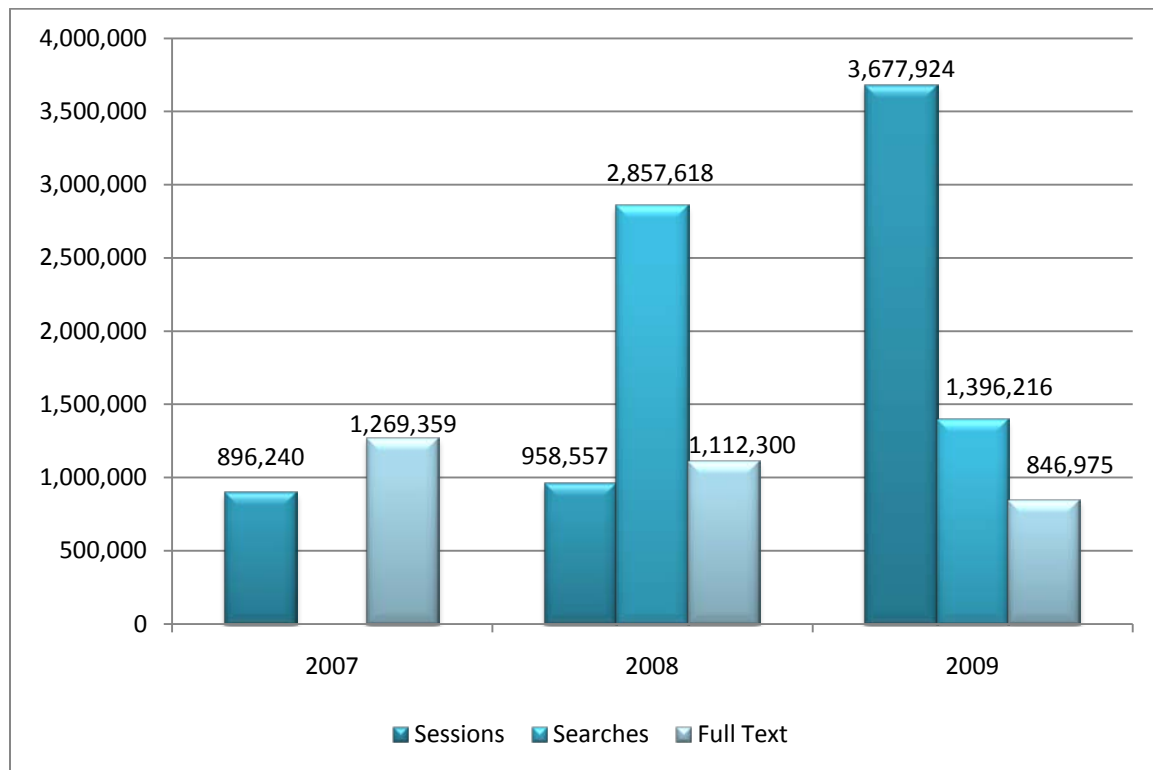
LiLI Users
