Scholarship applicants must be residents of a participating state (South Dakota, Wyoming, Idaho, or Montana) to qualify.

What SWIM brings to each participating state:

- At least ten scholarships (approximately 80% of tuition and fees) available to residents in each of the four states.
- Six students from each state will earn Masters of Library and Information Science degrees through the University of North Texas distance program.
- Four students from each state will earn School Library Media Endorsement credentials from one of the following:
 - University of Montana

- After graduation, scholarship recipients will work two years in a full-time professional librarian position in the SWIM region.
