BOISE, ID – Idaho residents now have free access to NovelList, an online reader’s advisory service created by librarians. NovelList gives readers a new way to find information about books that interest them and offers a host of resources for finding that next good read. Just one of the tools at LiLI.org provided by the Idaho Commission for Libraries, NovelList offers information about more than 180,000 fiction books and includes Recommended Reading Lists and Best-Seller Suggestions. The service allows readers to easily search by title, author, genre, or books in a series, effectively connecting readers to quality fiction.

“Finding an engrossing book fosters a love of reading and lifelong learning,” said State Librarian Ann Joslin. “With NovelList, readers can find more books by their favorite authors or search for authors who write in a similar fashion in Author Read-alikes.” NovelList also provides book reviews and Book Discussion Guides for book clubs. Readers can search for titles by popularity, awards, and much more. And, coming soon, readers will be able to find the Idaho Book of the Year winners in the “Award Winners” section of NovelList.
