



Sandwich Shop Math Game

Supplies:

Purchase craft foam sheets and cut into the sandwich pieces, as follows:

Bread: tan or beige foam – cut into squares

Ham: pink – cut into squares

Lettuce: green – cut into squares

Tomatoes: red – cut into circles

Cheese: orange – cut into squares or triangles

To play the game: Have children chose a menu card and count out the correct amount of each of the sandwich pieces to build their sandwich.

Directions: To prepare this game...print and cut apart the menu cards.

Insert clip art pictures of each food item on menu this will help young children and visual learners identify the correct items they should choose to build their sandwich.

Make signs with food picture to put by each food items for children to choose from. I would also print the food words...keep em reading and counting!

Change up each menu sheet

with 2 bread on each menu, but different amounts of food to create different sandwiches and food to count

I would let children keep one sandwich to keep and take home.

When introducing this activity remind children that the food is fake and should not be eaten.
