

Teens and Technology 2011: Course Overview and Requirements

Participants accepted into the course will be expected to:

- Complete webinar assignments
- Interview teens regarding their impressions of booktrailers and their impact on teen reading
- Post summary of interviews on WebJunction Teens and Technology group
- Participate in one hour webinar on Friday, January 14
- Possess a basic understanding of the operation of a FlipVideo camera before the regional workshop begins. (Libraries that do NOT already own a FlipVideo camera will be given one upon course enrollment.)
- Attend one regional workshop from 9:00-4:30 (mileage reimbursed for one-way travel over 40 miles).
 - Coeur d'Alene Public Library- Friday, January 28
 - Idaho Commission for Libraries – Tuesday, February 1
 - Blackfoot Technology Center – Thursday, February 3
 - Gooding High School Library – Friday, February 4
- Host Teen Tech Week (March 6-12, 2011) program. (A program is a one time or ongoing series of events designed specifically for teens and incorporating one or more of the technologies discussed in the course.)
- Collect data on number of teens participating in Teen Tech Week for final evaluation
- Create a booktrailer working with library teens
- Upload booktrailer to web and provide link to ICfL by Saturday, March 12
- Attend final one day meeting at ICfL on Friday, March 25 (travel expenses will be reimbursed)
- Complete course evaluation via SurveyMonkey

Course Completion:

Participants who complete all course requirements may very well receive a cool goodie or two!

Course Registration:

Registration is limited to 12 publicly funded library staff per region. More than one library staff from a library may apply; however they will only be accepted if space permits. Those staff who have already participated in Teens and Technology in either 2009 or 2010 may apply, but will only be admitted if space remains.
