[Edublogs.tv](http://Edublogs.tv) and [TeacherTube.com](http://TeacherTube.com) are recommended by teacher-librarians as an alternative to YouTube. You may use either one of these or any other site to post your partnership videos. Just send the url link to [Anne Abrams](mailto:Anne.Abrams@iclib.org).

You don't have to do anything fancy for this assignment! Here are some examples from Edublogs.tv:

[Library Tour](#) — This could be used before a class visits the library. Partnership: teacher & parents (media waiver).

[New Books](#) — If your parents helped raise money for new books, show it off in something like this! It doesn't have to be this slick—a simple point and tell would do.



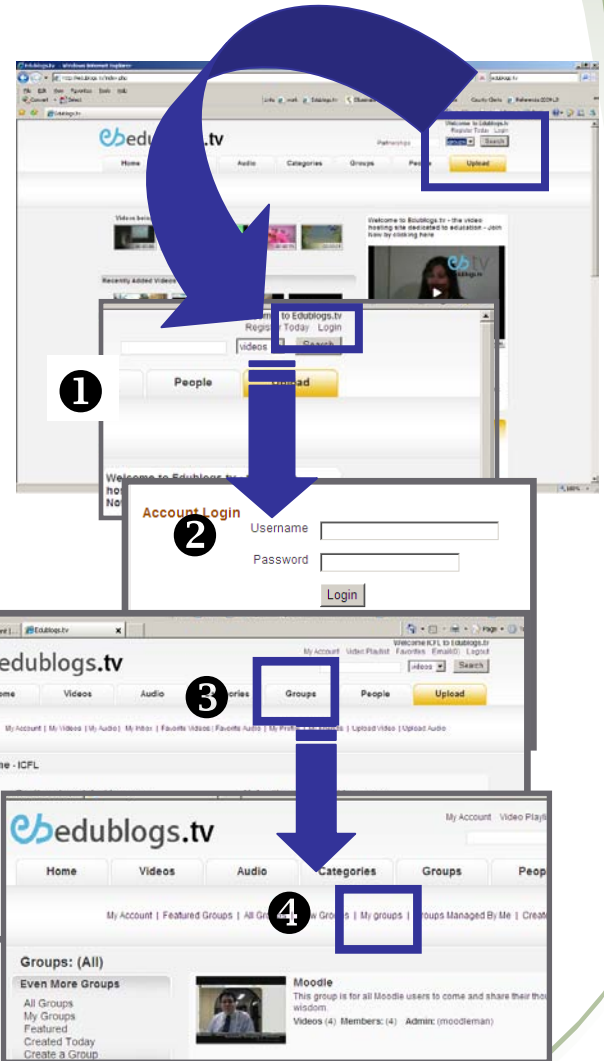
If you don't upload directly from your FlipCam, save your edited videos in a QuickTime movie (mov). To convert any video (except html) to an mp4 format, use Zamzar, [www.zamzar.com](http://www.zamzar.com). You don't have to set up an account, just complete the form. After the file is converted, the link will be emailed to you (it takes about an hour).

## Edublogs.tv

Compared to TeacherTube, I found this site the easiest to use for uploading. Email [Anne Abrams](mailto:Anne.Abrams@iclib.org) or [Shirley Biladeau](mailto:Shirley.Biladeau@iclib.org) or call them (334-2150 or 800 458-3271) to get the log in information.

Here is a step-by-step guide:

1. Go to [www.edublogs.tv](http://www.edublogs.tv) and click on "Login."
2. Fill in the Username and Password.
3. From the account page, click on "Groups"
4. Then, click on "My Groups."

5. Click on Upload

6. Fill out the information. Leave the first box blank. Complete the information.

- Tags: partnerships Idaho libraries
- Channel/Category: Professional Development Click the “Next” button

7. Upload your video — a popup window will appear —from your drive or FlipCam. It will take 5 to 10 minutes to appear on the site.

After your video uploads, you can find it again without logging in. Search “Idaho” through videos under the Register Today/Login text.

From the very early grades through college and beyond, these clips show great partnerships:

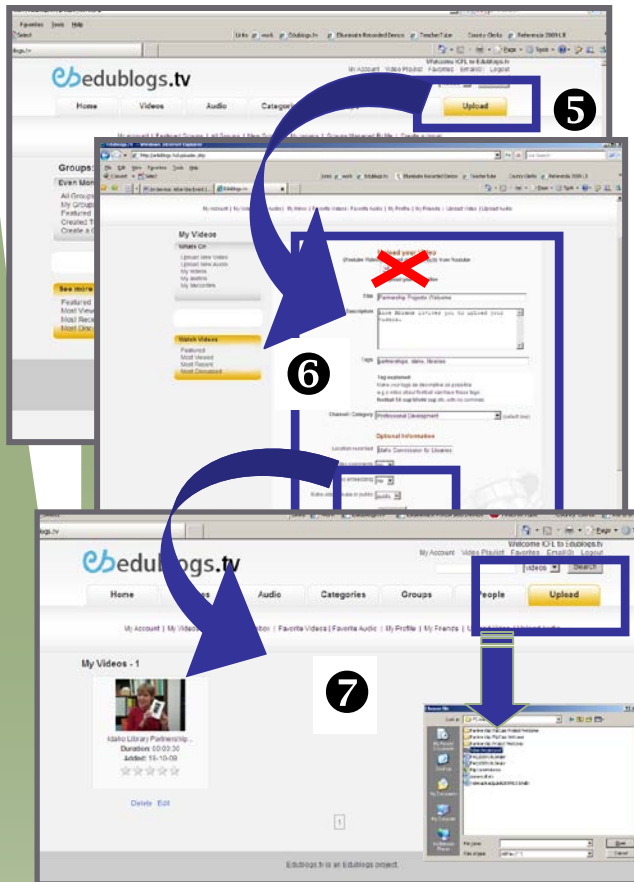
[Kids Educate](#) — This could be used before a class visits the library.

[Simple Interview](#) — Have your partner talk about your project.

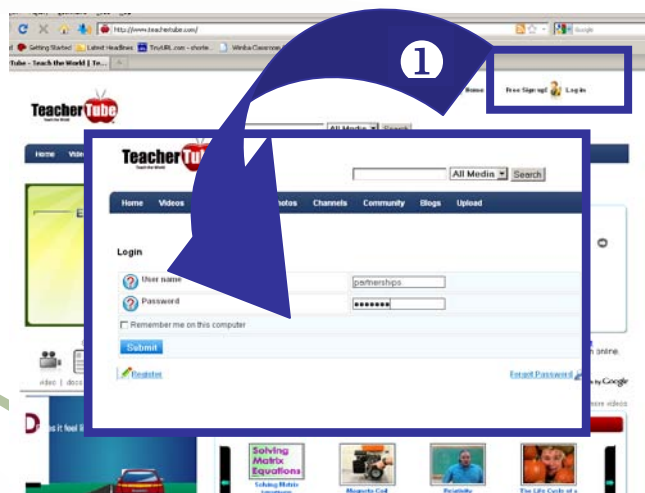


## UPLOADING VIDEOS ON TEACHERTUBE



TeacherTube allows you to upload a number of media formats (mpeg, wmv, avi, mov, mpg, flv, mp4, m4v), but it takes a little longer for it load.

1. Go to [www.teachertube.com](http://www.teachertube.com), and enter the User name and Password (get those from [Anne](#) or [Shirley](#)).

## TeacherTube.com — Uploading

2. Click on Upload Video
3. Complete the form:
  - Title: Your School Name
  - Tags: Idaho partnerships libraries
  - Video Category: Professional Development
  - Leave defaults in place for the rest of the selections
4. Click Continue Uploading
5. Click on Browse File — a popup window will appear —and upload your video from your drive or FlipCam.
6. Click on Upload
7. You'll receive a message your video has been successfully submitted. Sometimes uploads are delayed from being published for up to 24 hours.
