The Idaho Code defines a state publication as “any information, regardless of format, published by a state agency and intended for distribution to the public” and excludes internal and confidential information. As a general rule we do not collect advertisements,

announcements or ephemera.

GUIDELINES FOR INCLUSION

- Reports describing the activity of an agency or a subset of an agency
- Provides access to the information produced by one or more of the services
- Provides access to services
- Legislatively mandated
- Presents the results of a state task force, commission or of committee work
- Intended to be distributed and shared with the public
- Unique or substantial content
