Commissioner from Northern Idaho Appointed to ICfL Board

BOISE, ID –Pat Raffee, Kootenai County Chief Deputy Clerk, has been appointed by the Governor’s Office to the Idaho Commission for Libraries (ICfL) Board of Library Commissioners for a five-year term ending June 30, 2018. A lifelong library user, Raffee has served local libraries as a volunteer; as a Friend of the Library; and as co-founder, secretary, and current president of the Post Falls Library Foundation.

Raffee brings extensive public-sector experience to the Board of Commissioners. She is knowledgeable in policy making and budgeting processes. In addition, as a result of her role as Chief Deputy County Clerk and previously as Executive Director of two local urban renewal agencies, she is familiar with Idaho Code and complying with Open Meeting laws.

Raffee, who lives in Post Falls, fills the position on the Board that represents northern Idaho and replaces Bruce Noble, who served as the northern Idaho representative for 18 years.

The ICfL and the Board look forward to working with Raffee and will join her in a face-to-face Board Meeting in Lewiston on October 18, 2013.
