Programming Survival

Topic One: Prepare For large group – only two kids show up

- Be prepared for situations – always have a back-up plan
- Stick it out w/ enthusiasm – Keep smiling
- Emergency box w/ something to do (crafts, etc.)
- Librarians can swap stuff
- Empower kids to decide what to do

Topic Two: Material is NOT age Appropriate

- Good Planning – Communicate expectations to presenters
- Engage presenter w/ questions / comments / suggestions to lead presentation in appropriate direction – BE FLEXIBLE

Topic Three: Not enough materials for everyone

- Limit number of crafts / refreshments per child
- Crafts that don't need much preparation
- Get out the puppets
- Storytelling
