Recommendations include:

- \$60,000 ongoing in T&B for Kindergarten Readiness grants
- \$12,600 ongoing for EOR broadband reimbursement to public libraries; if more is needed, request supplemental funding in FY20
- FY19 supplemental requests for LiLI contract extensions and the increase in EOR reimbursement requests be taken from the FY19 \$200,000 appropriated for TBS only if the federal funds were zeroed out
- 3% CEC (change in employee compensation) through a 3% increase in the agency personnel appropriation, to be distributed based on merit
- \$3,300 for the agency share of state network core equipment replacement
- \$48,000 for the rent increase
- \$4,400 in state, \$1,100 in federal for increased benefit costs
- (\$17,000) in state, (\$6,900) in federal for a 1-time reduction in employer health benefit costs, due to need to reduce reserves in that statewide account
- \$5,600 net increase for SWCAP adjustments (fees to other state agencies)
