C. Grants – Summer STEM from Your Library Grant - \$500 Each – Information Item

The Idaho STEM Action Center provided funds to the Idaho Commission for Libraries (ICfL) to award public, school, or academic libraries \$500 each to help pay for materials or presenters to support STEM outreach efforts during the summer. ICfL provided a toolkit for learning activities, a branded yard sign, STEM books, and other resources. The Summer STEM program has three primary goals:

- Increase access to fun, engaging, hands-on STEM activities for underserved youth beyond the normal library programming efforts
- Increase children's access to books over the summer months
- Increase the number of children involved in STEM activities to minimize learning loss during the summer

This year we are including virtual and asynchronous STEM activities to qualify as outreach. For example, if gatherings of people are limited due to the coronavirus pandemic, libraries could demo STEM activities on social media, or create STEM kits to be picked up at food distribution sites. We also extended the time that the grant can be implemented to September 30 (previously August 31). Final reports are due to the ICfL by October 2020.
