

## **Questions to Expect on the SLA Mini-Grant – Upper Elementary Final Report:**

1. How many books per week was each student in your school allowed to check out, reported by grade level?
2. Please describe any challenges or feedback you've received as a result of checking out books for children to take home during the Spring 2022 semester.
3. We are thrilled by the student reactions to new books that were reported in the Interim Reports – it's one of the best things about this grant program! Besides the excitement of the children for the new books and being able to check out books, what was the biggest success in your project? Some examples might be higher reading scores, a shift to a culture of reading in the school, a change of heart for teachers and parents for students to take books home to read, etc.
4. Referring to the Need Statement in your application, please describe how these grant funds helped your library program meet the stated need.
5. How many books did you purchase with your grant funds?
6. What percentage of your funds were spent on nonfiction books?
7. Did you help organize an Idaho Family Reading Week or other family literacy event at your school since your Interim Report was filed?
8. Please describe how you executed your plan to increase students' out-of-school reading time.
9. Attach an order summary, packing slip, or other document list showing the book titles you have purchased. Only include the titles purchased since you filed the Interim Report and titles that were not included on that list. This document should be a PDF. Please do not use a photo – the image is too small to read.
10. Provide any additional comments or feedback.
11. Please read the financial report instructions carefully and initial here that you understand the requirements.
12. The amount your school was awarded.
13. Please attach a financial report produced by your school or school district's accounting software (not a spreadsheet) that shows the grant funds you received, and the transactions that spent the balance down to zero.
14. What amount of grant funds have been spent? (This should be all the grant funds with nothing left over).
15. Has more than 5% of your total grant award been spent on vendor processing or labeling fees?
16. Please describe any obstacles that you encountered ordering book titles and using grant funds.
