## V. FEDERAL FUND

## A.1 Program – LSTA Reauthorization – Information Item

The Institute of Museum and Library Services (IMLS) federal FY2023 budget provided Grants to States with level funding at \$168,803 million, which keeps the base at \$833,845 for states. Any fluctuations compared to last year are based on population shifts and Maintenance of Effort distribution which was less than the year prior (\$525K to redistribute this year compared to \$924K last year).

Idaho's allotment this year is \$1,522,646. Last year's allotment was \$1,524,829. The small decrease is due to the level funding IMLS received (in FY22 IMLS received a \$2 million increase from FY21) and fewer Maintenance of Effort funds to redistribute. ICfL's cost share portion is \$784,393.39 for a total of \$2,307,039.39 to be spent on LSTA programs.
