Libraries apply on a continuous basis for LSTA-funded Continuing Education Grants. CE activities must support an identified need that is consistent with one the following goals:

- Build the institutional capacity of libraries to best serve their communities.
- Strengthen the role of libraries and library staff as community educators and community connectors.
- Ensure equitable access to information and reading materials through direct service to Idahoans.

The summary below includes both the awards and the reimbursement payments since payments are often made months after the grant agreement/award is signed. The FY2023 budget was increased from \$45,000 to \$60,000 after the mid-year budget review in early December 2022.
