A.2. Finances – That All May Read Grant Applications Received – Information item

The That All May Read Grant for \$1,000 is available to public libraries throughout Idaho. This grant is designed to assist libraries in building large-print collections, obtaining assistive technology, and/or providing outreach to people who are unable to read standard print due to a visual impairment, blindness, or other perceptual or physical disability, or have difficulty holding a book. This grant helps libraries to build the capacity to best serve their communities. It also improves equitable access to information and reading materials in alternate formats for Idahoans unable to read standard-print books. This grant is being carried out in conjunction with the Talking Book Service (TBS). A requirement of accepting the funds is an agreement to promote the TBS in local communities. This is the second year of the grant program. Thirty-one libraries applied and all will be funded (\$30,000 with state funds; \$1,000 from Board-Approved LSIF for TBS projects). Libraries highlighted in green are new applicants this year.
