The Idaho Commission for Libraries’ Welcoming Libraries Grant is available to Idaho public, school, or tribal libraries working with children ages 0-18. The grants support libraries as they work to make materials, programs, and spaces more welcoming and accessible to all children. These grants are made possible with Library Services and Technology Act (LSTA) funds. In fiscal year 2024, the ICfL received 13 Welcoming Libraries Grant applications and was able to fund all of them.
