

## Regular visits to your library can foster a love of reading and learning

- Children who enjoy books will want to learn to read and are more likely to become lifelong readers.
- Visit the library together and go often!
- Make your library visits a special night or day of the week. Make a big deal about it.
- Make reading a special time between you and your child.
- Let your child choose his or her own books according to their interests.
- Check out some books for yourself while you are visiting the library. If your child sees that you enjoy reading and treat books with respect it is likely they will too.
- Sign up your child for the library's summer reading program.

## How to apply for a library card

If you don't already have a card, you will need to bring the following items with you to the library to apply:

- Driver's License with current address
- OR another form of picture ID and proof of current address such as a utility bill or bank statement.
