

# Checking multiple library collections in Libby

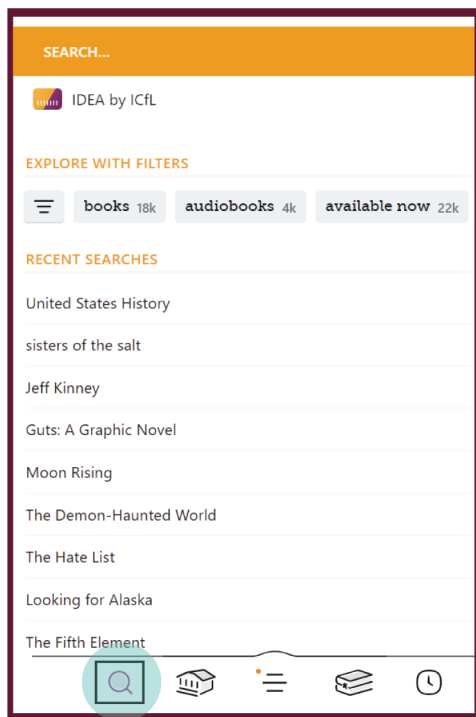


The title you wanted is checked out at your home library, but how can you quickly check all those other libraries you added in Libby? Open the Libby app and follow these instructions to learn how.

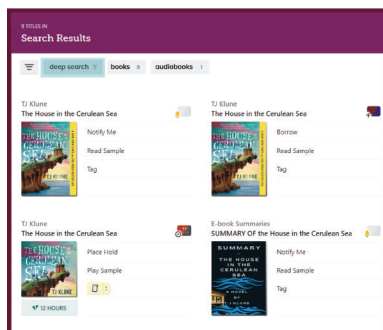
**Before continuing, make sure you've added these partner libraries, so you have access to their collections:**

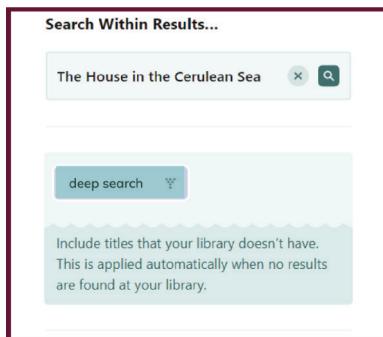
**1** Search for the title you want in your home library.



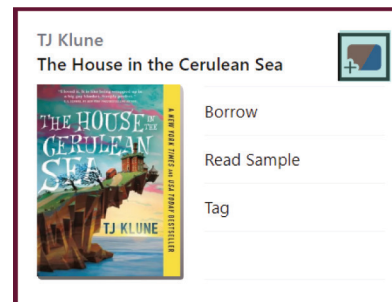
**2** Make sure Deep Search is displaying at the top of the screen.



If deep search is NOT at the top of the screen, select the icon of three lines at the top left of the screen, scroll down, and select "Deep Search."



**3** Swipe up to scroll through the list of all your libraries. If a library has an available copy, the library card icon next to the title will have a plus sign on it. Tap the icon to borrow the title.



Note: If the library icon is gray with a yellow bell, then the title is not currently available at any of your added libraries. You can add it to your "Notify Me" list. If one of your libraries purchases the title, you will be notified.

**4** Choose the length of loan period you prefer.

**5** Tap Borrow!
