3) access to digital literacy training

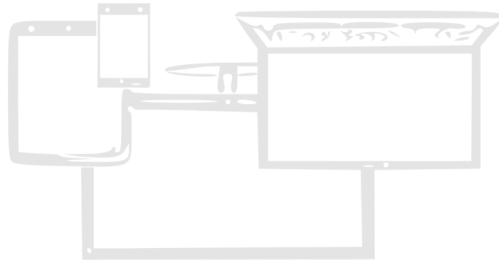
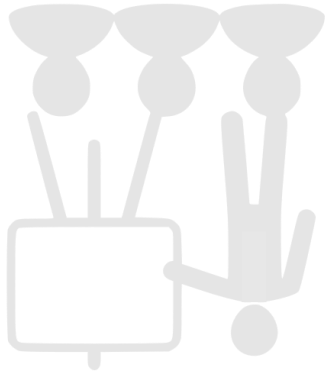
