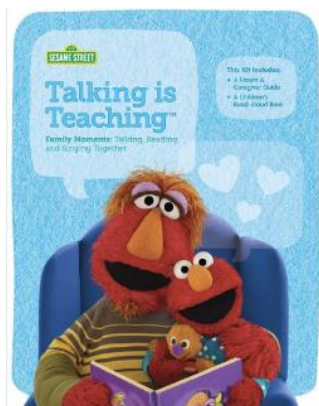


Spanish and Bilingual Education Materials for Idaho Libraries

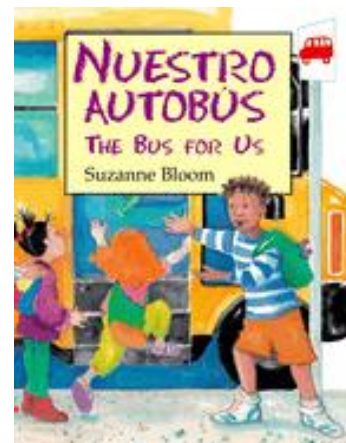

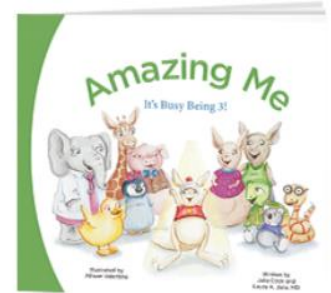

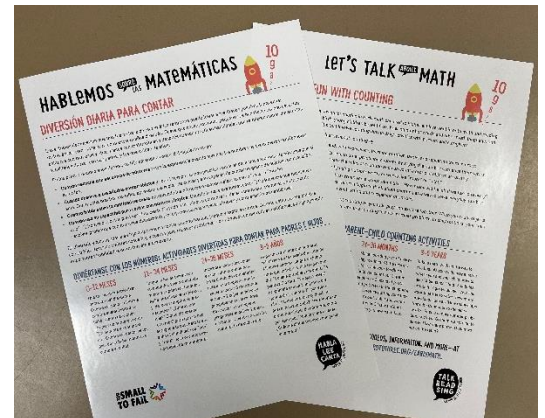
