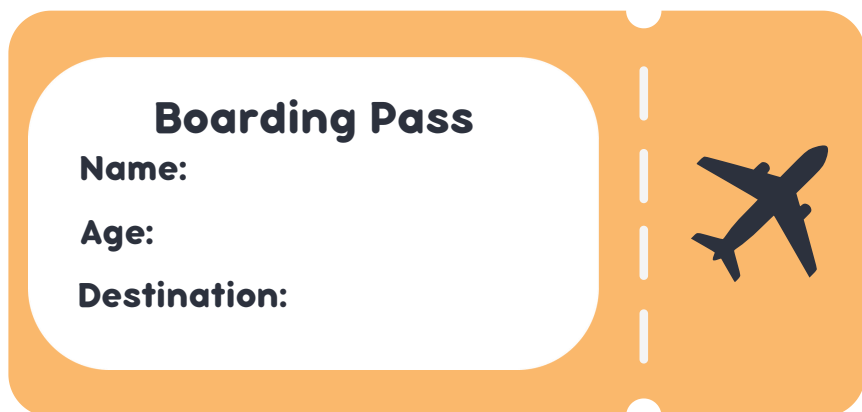

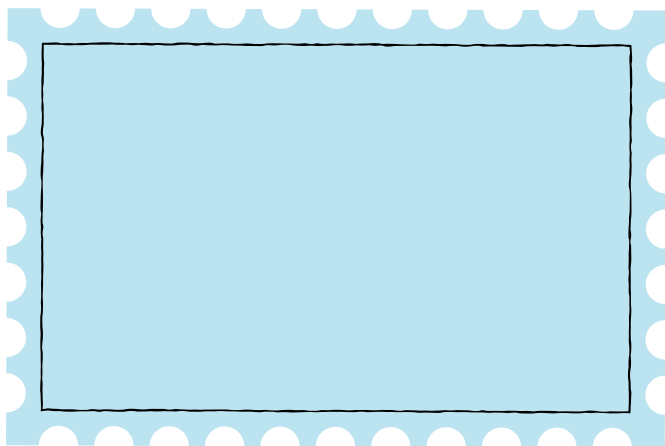

Fasten your seatbelts, rev up your engines, and get ready to explore! Grab your pens, pull out your markers, and let's embark on an adventure.

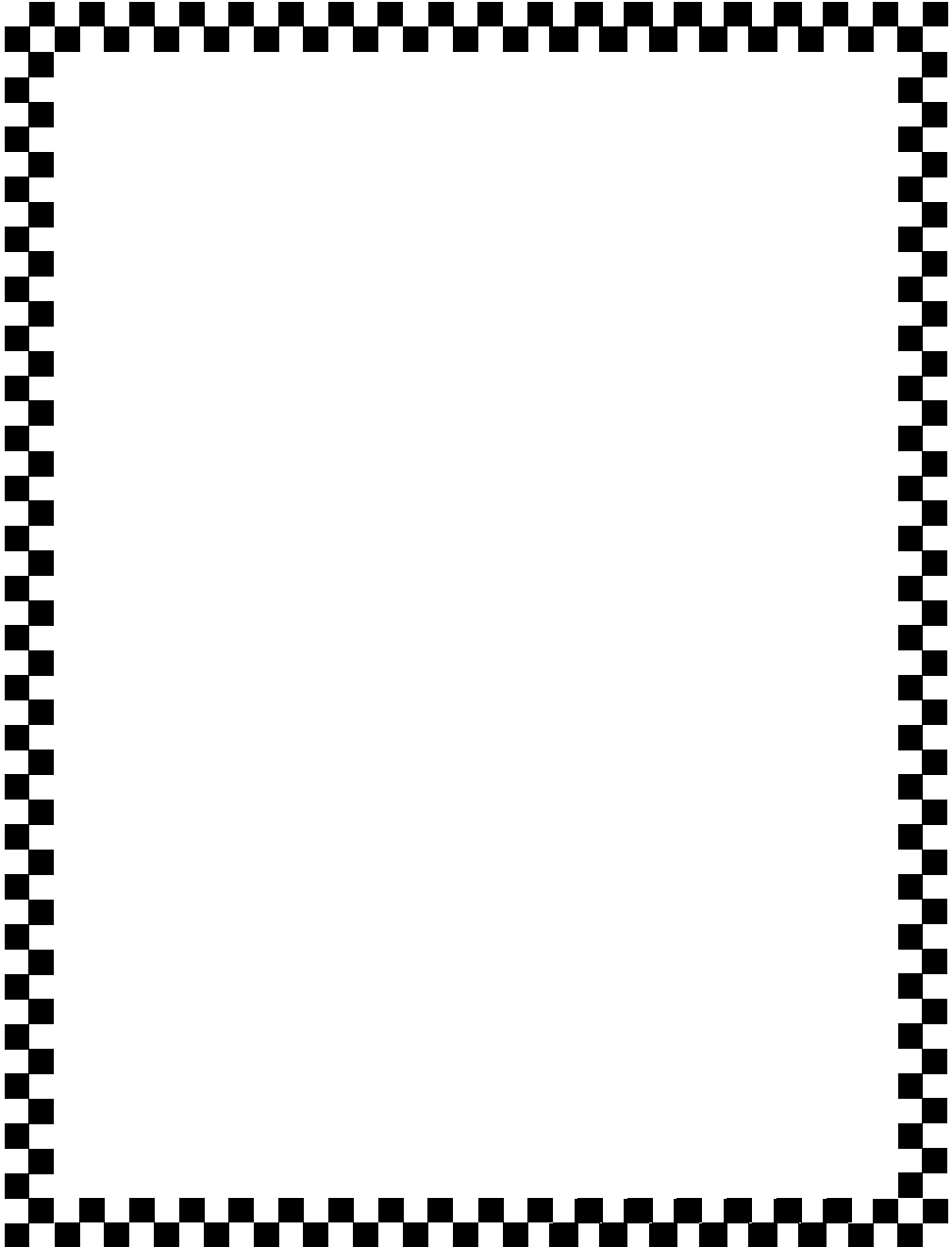


Create a stamp with a drawing of your favorite form of transportation. Is it a train? Vintage car? Airplane?



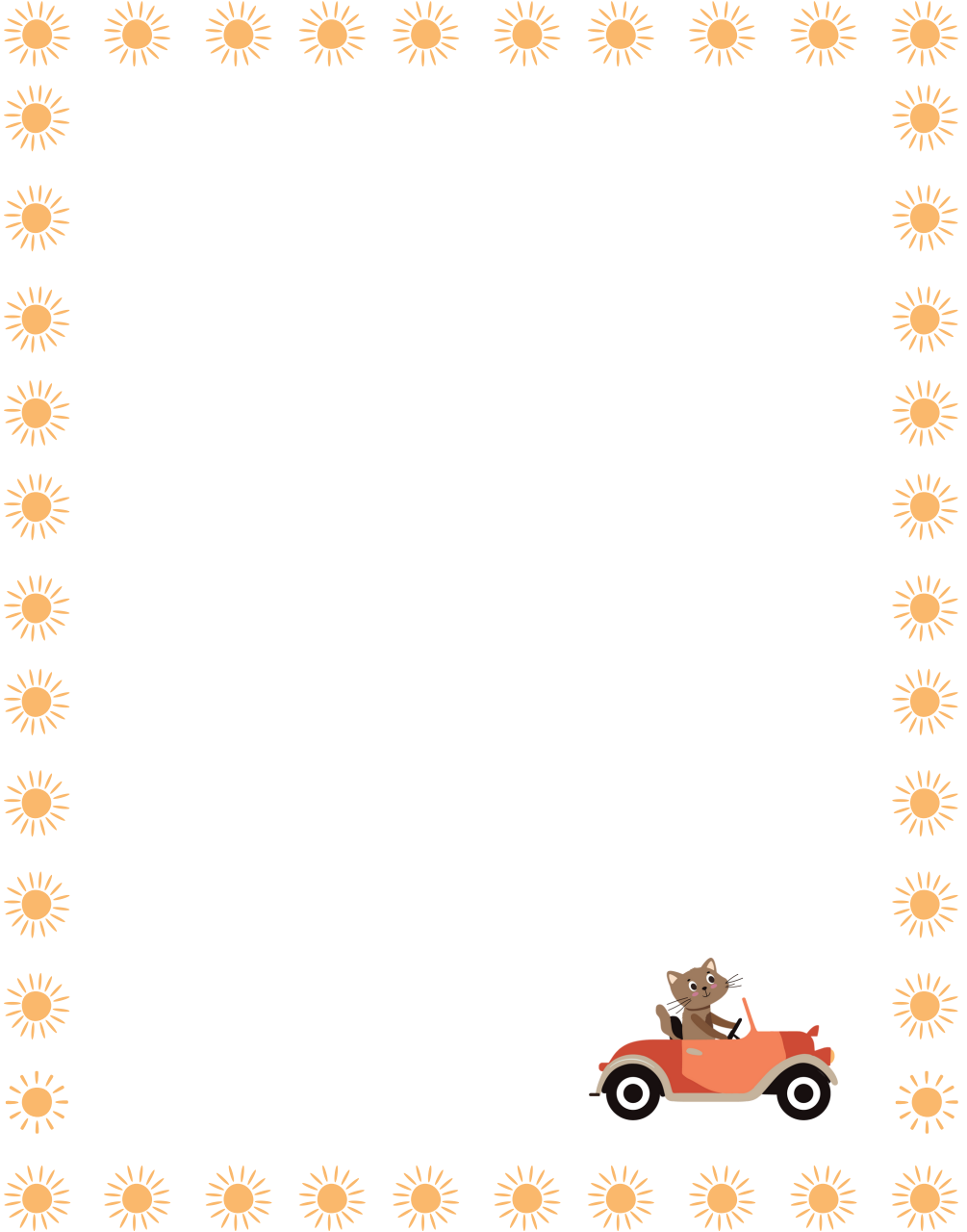
Dream Car

Design your dream car. Have fun drawing a picture of what it looks like. Make sure to label any cool features.

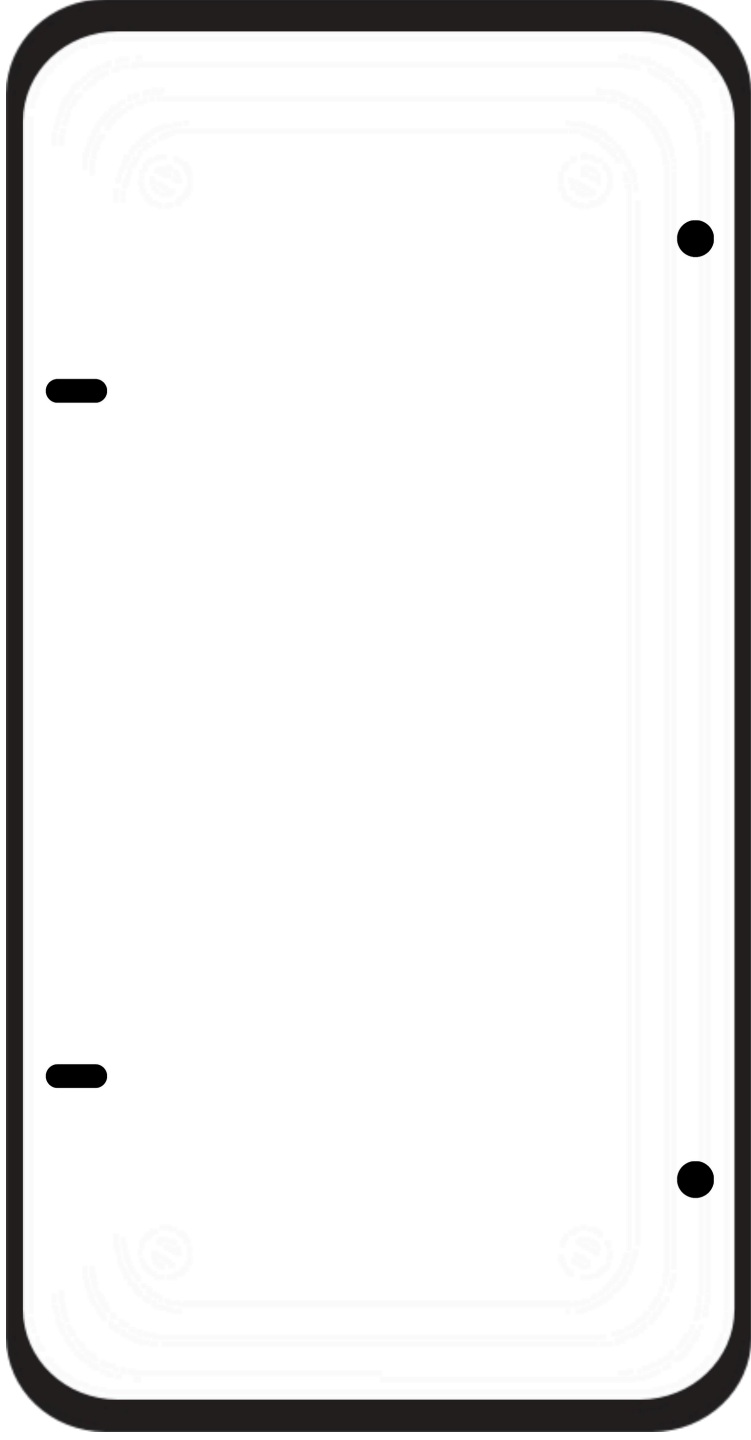


Road Trip!

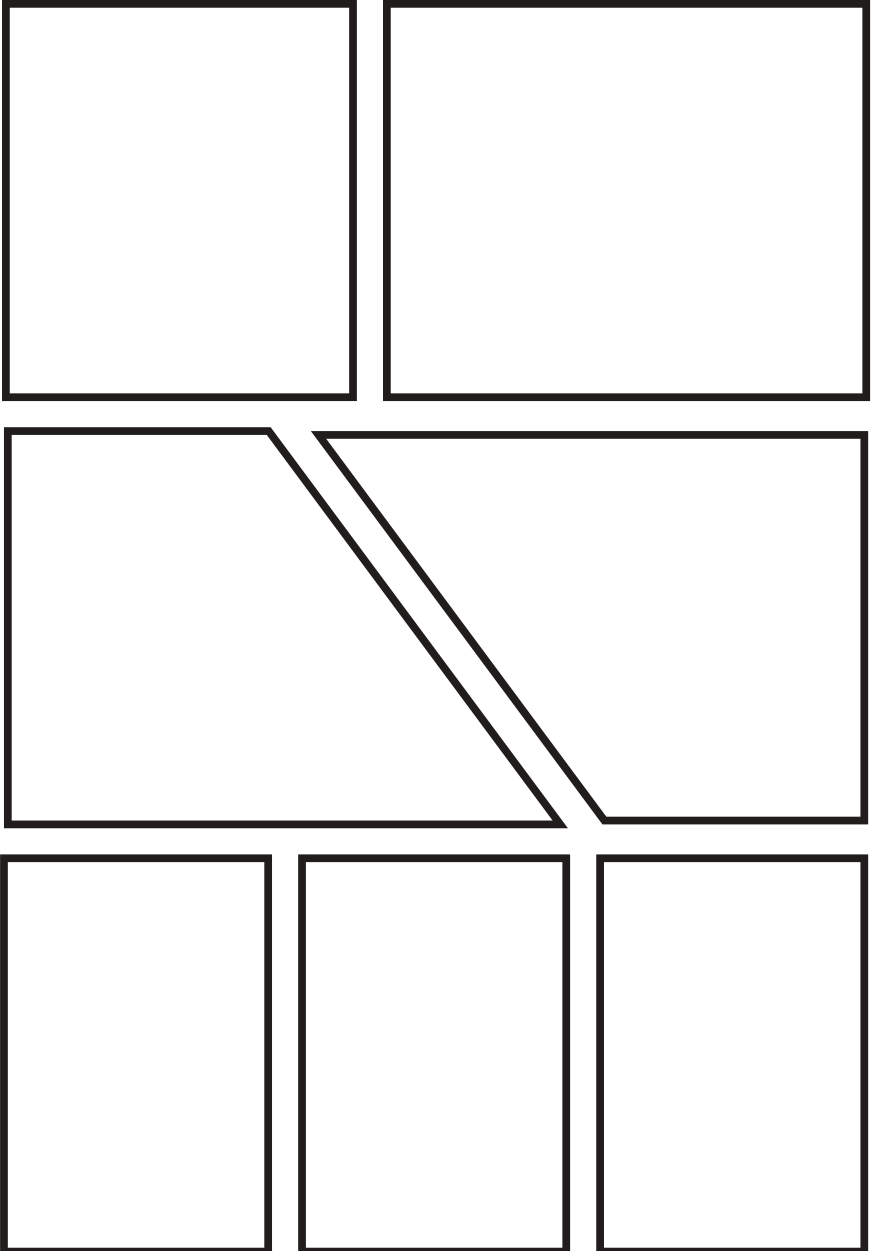

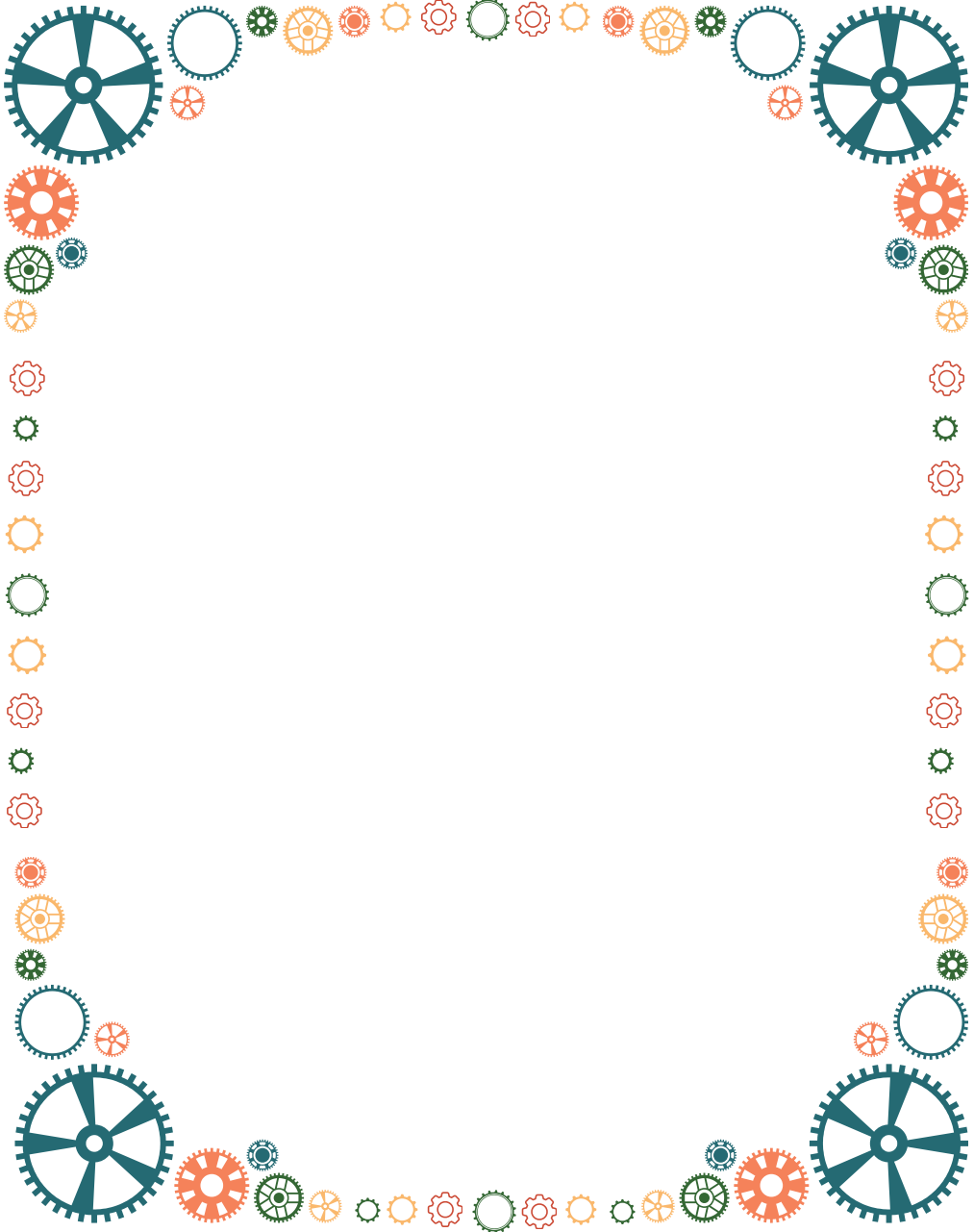
Create A Comic!

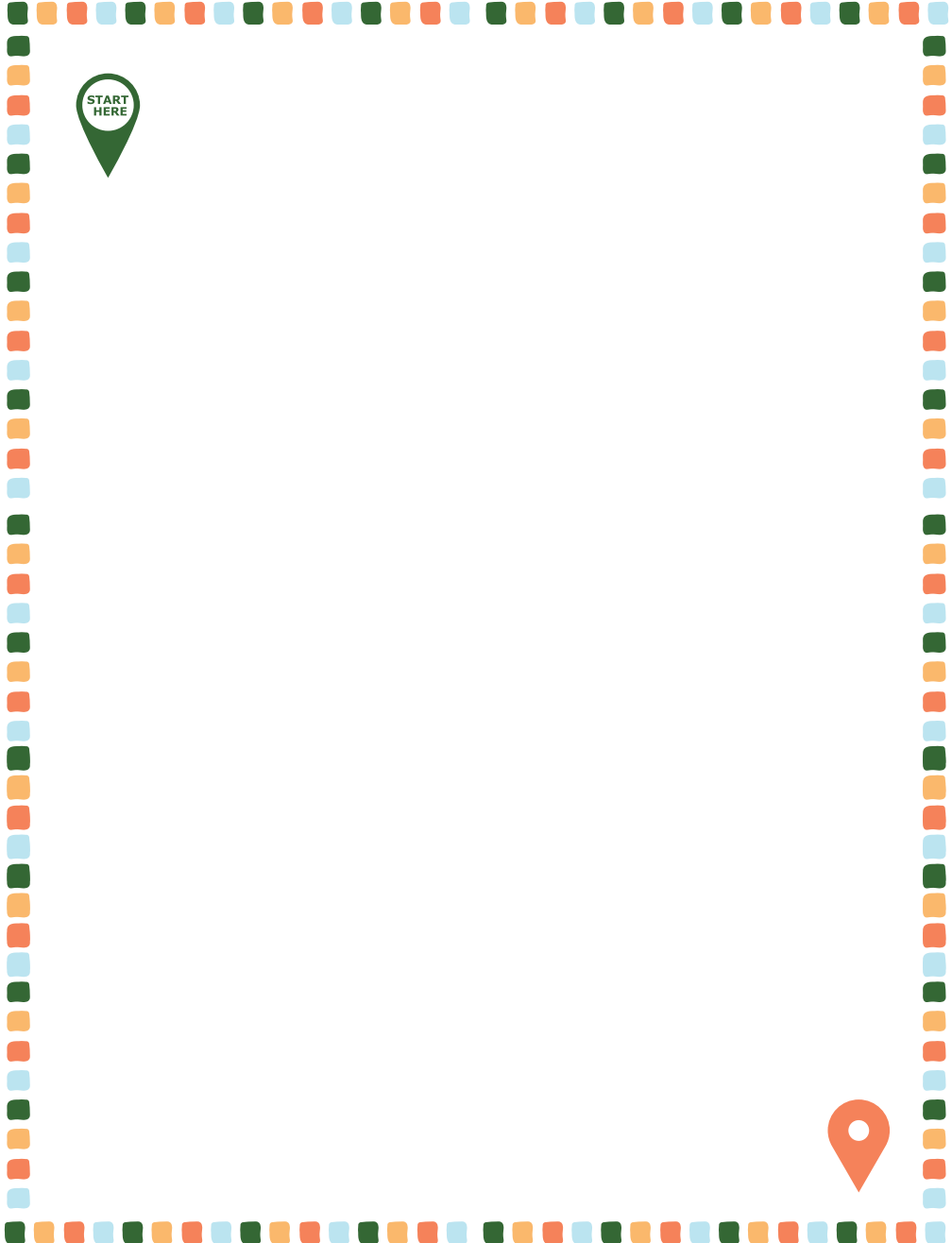
Time Warp

Write a poem using one of the following poetry prompts:

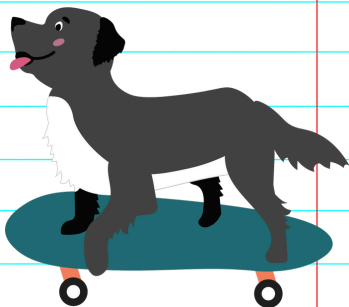
The Midnight Train:
