

**My First Books Outcomes** 

As a result of the My First Books program:

- Participating children increase their access to books by starting a home library.
  - Receive one book each month during program year
- More underserved families have library cards and use the public library.
  - o Family events/parent workshops held at public library
  - o Access to families through partners
  - Some libraries may issue special nonresident cards for free/low cost to participating families
  - o Suggestions in monthly newsletter, "The Bookworm"
- Participating children increase early literacy skills.
  - o Librarians focus on skills during monthly storytimes
  - o Librarians provide training/modeling for child care providers
  - o Children practice early literacy skills with monthly books
- Parents of participating children increase their knowledge about early literacy.
  - o Family event/parent workshop focuses on early literacy skills
  - Information and home activities that reinforce early literacy skills through "The Bookworm" (English, Spanish)
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- Libraries strengthen community partnerships.
  - Collaborative partnership with child care providers, Head Start, preschools, public schools, teen parent programs, etc.
