**Arizona Digital Inclusion Directory**

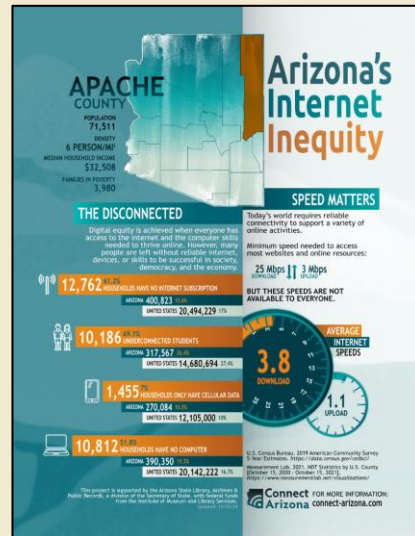
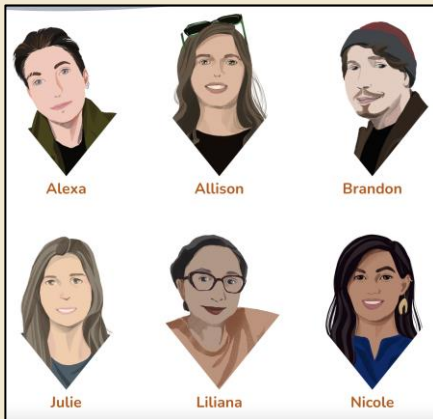
