4. How many books have you purchased with your grant funds so far?
5. What percentage of those titles were age-appropriate non-fiction?
6. Did you help organize an Idaho Family Reading Week or other family literacy event for your school (in-person, virtual, or remote)? If so, what were the results? How many families participated? Did you receive feedback about the event? Did you have an opportunity to educate families about the services and benefits of your library?
7. If you've not yet held an event, please provide a short description of your plans.
8. You will attach a title list of the books you've purchased so far. Our electronic form requires a PDF, please.
9. Additional Comments: Please provide any additional comments that would provide further explanation or would help us improve this program.
10. You will attach a financial report that has been produced by your school's or district's accounting software. It should clearly show the grant funds hitting the account, and each transaction for book purchases. Again, the electronic form requires a PDF.
11. What amount of your grant funds have been spent to date?
12. Has more than 5% been spent on vendor processing or labeling fees? If so, how much?
13. In the spirit of ICfL's quest for continual improvement, please describe any challenges that occurred ordering book titles and using grant funds.
