Once signed up, a TBS patron can receive their audiobooks and/or magazines on cartridges and/or through a download option.

The TBS audiobook
cartridges are mailed
to and from a patron's
residence via the USPS.
Materials are sent "free
matter" so there is
NO COST to the patron.
Once a patron is finished
listening to the
audiobook cartridge, they
simply turn the mailing
card over and put it in
their outgoing mail.
