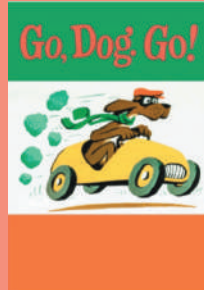

By: P.D. Eastman

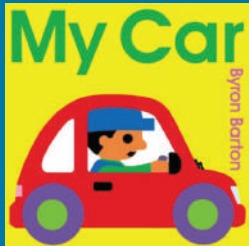
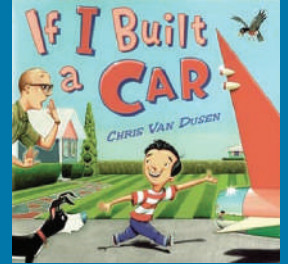

My Car

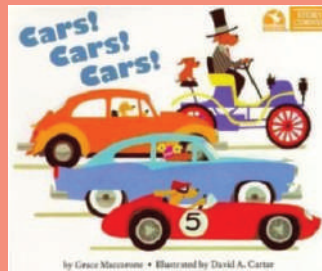
By: Byron Barton

By: Grace Maccarone

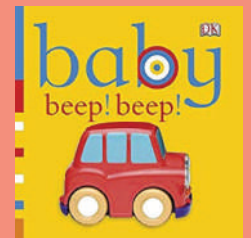
This simple little book is it fun to read, it will teach about opposites, colors, and numbers.



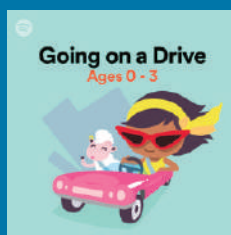
Baby beep! beep!
