Career Prep Resources Available for Idahoans through Learning Express

BOISE, Idaho –Idahoans have free, 24/7 access to career preparation resources through the expansive LearningExpress Library via the <u>lili.org</u> platform, provided by the Idaho Commission for Libraries (ICfL).

Under the "career preparation" tab of LearningExpress, users will find information about a variety of careers, including the culinary arts, law enforcement, nursing, and teaching. There are also resources for people changing careers and for veterans transitioning to post-military employment.

Many careers require applicants to pass a proficiency exam. LearningExpress includes a number of career exams for interested job seekers to use as practice. Some of the available exams include those for: civil service; commercial driver's license; cosmetology; electrician; firefighting; hospitality; law enforcement; nursing; plumbing; real estate; social work; and teaching.

The career prep section of LearningExpress also has tools to help people conduct a successful job search; create an effective résumé and cover letter; interview with confidence; negotiate a salary; and learn networking skills. There is also business writing help and tips for achieving professional success.
